## SPIDER PLANT

Native to South Africa

## <u>LIGHT</u>

Plants enjoy natural light, but not direct sunlight. You should place your plants near a window but not directly in them, this will cause browning of the leaves.

## <u>WATER</u>

Water liberally through the summer. Mist occasionally. During winter, cut watering back.

## <u>FACTS</u>

If you keep your plants in proper condition, you will soon notice spider 'babies' forming on your spider plant.

These babies look like little miniature spider plants suspended from a longer branch of the plant. Treat your plants with a bit of house plant fertilizer from time to time, using half of the recommended strength. Spider plants are sensitive and need only a bit of fertilizer to stay healthy.

You can even do without the fertilizer if your

plants are looking well.
